

In this volume, four scholars at the Washington School Research Center at Seattle Pacific University present original research drawn from statistical studies of state educational data and from thousands of classroom observations carried out by the Baker Educational Research Group. They assess the current state of math education and review its history and development. The authors also provide a dispassionate review of the extensive international, national, and state literature. If America's goal of educational equity and excellence is to be achieved, then math teachers everywhere must be fully supported in developing the specific skills that are ideal for educating all students. The authors' discussion focuses on four principles for improving math teaching and learning: fidelity to reform efforts by all involved; an emphasis on instruction and instructional tools; the critical nature of mathematical knowledge; and, the need for transformational change.
